- Landscaping with trees and plants for Green environment.




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#### RESTRICTED ENTRY OF AUTOMOBILES

- > Two wheelers and four wheelers of the students are not allowed to enter into the college campus.
- > Students are advised to use public transport or college bus for transport.
- Public transport is available for the benefit of the students from various locations such as Chennai, Vellore, Tiruppathi and Kancheepuram.
- > The security guards are employed for strict monitoring of students entry and ledgers are maintained for the entry of visitors, staff and students.

- ➤ E- Vehicle is in active use for moving the faculty, staff, students and outside visitors from one area to other relevant locations.
- ➤ Bi-Cycle usage is encouraged in the campus.
- ➤ The E- Vehicle is originally being utilized by the physically challenged GRT COE Students teachers and visitors of multiple purposes.
- ➤ E Vehicle with six- seater ensures the nil carbon foot print for the timely transportation of people inside the campus.

- ➤ Student's professional associations are in-charge of raising awareness programs highlighting the importance of a plastic free green campus.






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### Plastic plates were replaced with eco-friendly plates





### Plastic dustbins were replaced with metal bins







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### 4. Move towards paperless office
