In the pedagogical approach, which we call the Teaching Clinic, combining service-learning and design-based research to create meaningful learning engagements. The Teaching Clinic (TC) is a course for Master students in a teacher education curriculum at an Austrian university. Established teachers submit research questions about current professional challenges. These questions are then picked up by students, who conceptualize and execute research projects to find evidence based solutions.
